## TASTING NOTES



### Vintage

Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault

### Terroir

Abundant sunshine ensures ideal ripening conditions, tempered by the cooling influence of the Mistral winds from the north and gentle sea breezes from the south. The vines flourish in a mix of clay and sandy soils, perfectly suited to their needs.

### Winemaking

To preserve the delicate berry aromas, vibrant fruit flavours, and balanced acidity, we harvest the grapes early and press them immediately. The lightly tinted juice is then transferred to chilled tanks, where we can control the fermentation process and maintain the fresh berry-fruit character. This careful attention from start to finish results in an elegant, Provence-style rosé that's a true pleasure to drink. The final alcohol content is 12.5%

### Tasting Note

A pale pink hue that captures the essence of the South of France. The nose is lifted and fragrant, offering notes of rose petals, strawberries, and a hint of fresh thyme. On the palate, it's elegantly textured with a soft, creamy mouthfeel balanced by crisp citrus acidity. Finishes dry and refreshing, with lingering notes of a saline minerality that evoke sea breeze and sunshine.
